Congratulations! As a College Bound student, you have already taken the first step in preparing for your education after high school.

Scholarship Requirements

To receive the scholarship for college, you need to fulfill your College Bound Pledge to graduate from a Washington State high school or home school with a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher and have no felony convictions, and you must:

1. Meet the scholarship award income eligibility requirements. When you apply for financial aid, your family's income must be within 65% of the state's median family income (see the chart at readysetgrad.org/cbs-mfi for the dollar amounts, but remember that the amounts change each year).
2. Be a U. S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen (as determined by the U.S. Department of Education). Students with DACA status who meet scholarship residency requirements may also be eligible.
3. Attend college within one year of high school graduation. College Bound is a four-year scholarship (eight semesters or 12 quarters) that you must use within five years of high school graduation.
